## **Please Note:**

Some of these items get stored on Campus and become "Community Property". Things like tissue, copy paper, Disinfectant wipes, etc... other supplies are for your student to have at their disposal at any given time, i.e. paper, pencil, pen, eraser, etc... Any excess supplies will be sent home for you to store and give to your student on an as needed basis.

- 1. Do not buy perforated spiral bound notebooks. The spiral bound notebooks create a mess when torn out. We don't want this. The students should have a composition book for every subject.
- 2. No Sharpies for students, only Teachers. If you want to buy some for the Teachers, thanks.
- 3. While personal pencil sharpeners are convenient, and quiet, they tend to be messy. If your student has one, there's a good chance we'll end up taking it and the teachers will keep them.
- 4. Occasionally we will allow certain students to use a mechanical pencil, but for the most part they become toys, and the kids fidget with them and ultimately just take them apart. See. #3 above.
- 5. There is no need for a backpack of any kind. The Trapper Keeper will suffice.
- 6. Being properly prepared for work is fundamental. A student not having the basic items they need to work will have their S.W.E.A.T. grade reduced accordingly.
