

Items may be added or removed based on supply. If there is something that you definitely do not want your child to have, please contact the office. We do limit items based on sugar content and quantity.





Please remember to follow the diagram during drop-off and pick-up. This will keep the flow of traffic smooth. At 8:50 the side gate is shut to keep the cars from the neighborhood from driving through the parking lot. At 1:45 it is reopened for dismissal. During the hours of 8:50 to 1:45 please use the Dunn Avenue gate for access to the property. We will let you know when this will change due to the construction of the PE building.

The side gates are closed between 8:45 and 1:45. You must enter and exit the property through the Dunn Avenue gate during the day.



Due to recent active threats around the country, we have taken a serious look at how we keep your child safe while they are in our care. Due to this reevaluation, we will be changing

some of the ways we do things. The first change will be afternoon dismissal. I would ask that you please be pa-

tient with us as we work out the kinks. A quick reminder that while our door is always "open," you must sign in at the front desk any time you are on campus for more than just an early pick up.
